

Schedule confirmed: European Championships Munich 2022 are taking shape

50 years after the 1972 Summer Olympics, Munich will once again host a multi-sport event: The second edition of the European Championships will see nine European Championships taking place 'under one roof' from 11 to 21 August 2022. Fans can look forward to the best athletes from all over Europe competing in 176 exciting medal decisions.

With the Olympic Games and Olympiapark celebrating their 50-year anniversary in 2022, the City of Munich will be dressing up for a sensational, golden jubilee. The sporting highlight will be the European Championships Munich 2022 from 11 to 21 August 2022, combining the European Championships in athletics, beach volleyball, canoe sprint, cycling, gymnastics, rowing, sport climbing, table tennis, and triathlon. Preparations are in full swing, as the one-year-to-go mark is approaching. With the confirmation of the schedule for each of the nine championships, the biggest multi-sport event since the 1972 Olympic Games continues to take shape and provides the participating federations, broadcasters, governing body of the European Championships as well as the organising committee of host city Munich with planning security.

The second edition of the combined European Championships will feature approximately around 4,700 of the best athletes from about 50 nations, competing in 176 medal decisions for the title of European champion. In addition to the nine Olympic sports, the sports programme has been expanded to include para events in canoe sprint and rowing, increasing the event count from 158 to 176 and adding to the remarkable diversity of Munich 2022.

'With the confirmation of the schedule, we have successfully completed an important organisational step. With 176 medal decisions in eleven days, our spectators can expect a gripping and varied sports programme every day. I am particularly pleased that Olympiapark, the landmark of Munich's sporting culture, will be the venue for exciting competitions every day. The other attractive medal events at the Olympic Regatta Centre, Königsplatz, Odeonsplatz, Rudi-Sedlmayer-Halle and Messe München will ensure an international sporting festival like the one we experienced at the 1972 Summer Olympics,' says Marion Schöne, Managing Director of Olympiapark München GmbH.

The European Championships Munich 2022 will be broadcast by the European Broadcasting Union, with the competitions televised in up to 56 countries across Europe. The European Broadcasting Union already broadcast the premiere of the European Championships in Berlin and Glasgow, accumulating a television audience of more than 1.4 billion.

Nine European championships 'under one roof' – with the European Championships 2022 Munich welcomes the biggest sporting event since the 1972 Olympic Games and puts the former Olympic venues at the heart of the event. From 11-21 August 2022, over 4,700 athletes will compete in the Olympic sports of athletics, beach volleyball, canoe sprint, cycling, gymnastics, rowing, sport climbing, table tennis and triathlon in the second edition of the multi-sport European Championships, which were first held in Berlin and Glasgow in 2018. Europe's sporting elite and 176 medal events guarantee exciting and top-class competitions. In addition to top sporting performances, all participants can look forward to the festival "The Roofs". The varied supporting programme will round off Munich 2022 culturally in the anniversary year and make it a holistic, unforgettable experience.

The European Championships Munich 2022 feature nine participating Federations: European Athletics, Confédération Européenne de Volleyball, European Canoe Association, Union Européenne de Cyclisme, European Gymnastics, World Rowing, International Federation of Sport Climbing, European Table Tennis Union, and Europe Triathlon.

3. The European Broadcasting Union (EBU), the umbrella body for Europe's free-to-air channels, is the Official Broadcast Partner of the European Championships Munich 2022.
4. European Championships Management (ECM) manages and coordinates the European Championships in cooperation with the participating Federations, host cities and broadcast partners, continuously developing the event concept.
5. The inaugural European Championships in Glasgow and Berlin took place through 2-12 August 2018. The event provided a unique platform to elevate the Champions of Europe. A cumulative television audience of 1.4 billion watched this memorable first edition on free-to-air channels in 44 territories across Europe and worldwide. There were 1.9 billion visits on websites registered and the reach on social media was 945 million.
